

"Privacy Policy"

This privacy policy sets out how Advance: The Disability Consultants uses and protects any information that you give Advance when you use this website. Advance: The Disability Consultants may change this policy from time to time by updating this page. You should check this page from time to time to ensure that you are happy with any updates we have made to this policy.

Who is the controller of the data that you provide us?

Advance: The Disability Consultants will be what's known as the 'Controller' of the personal data you provide to us. We will collect certain data about you including your name and email address and any other personally identifiable information that is deemed relevant to the business.

What we collect?

We may collect the following information:

- Name and job title
- Contact information including email address
- Demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests
- Other information relevant to customer surveys and/or offers

Why we collect the information?

We need to know your personal data in order to allow us to properly and safely operate our business. In particular, Advance: The Disability Consultants will use the data to contact you in relation to news, updates about seminars/workshops/, invoicing, records of invoices paid and outstanding (and any agreed payment terms) and any other information relevant to the business. We will only collect personally identifiable information that you provide us with.

What we do with the information we gather

We use this information for the following reasons:

- To improve our products and services.

- We would like to use your information to contact you for market research purposes. We may contact you by email, phone, fax, or mail if you have consented to it. We may use the information to customise the website according to your interests.

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical and electronic procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.
